**Upscale Car Show Offers Discounts Throughout April
Tickets to 2019 Atlanta Concours d'Elegance will be reduced to \$55**

The 2019 Atlanta Concours d'Elegance, one of the prestigious car shows in the east, will be moving its location to Tyler Perry Studios this fall. And to celebrate, organizers are reducing ticket prices during the month of April.

"We believe this is a premier event that everyone in Atlanta needs to be a part of," said Bill Walleit, CEO of the Concours.

"We are proud to have this event in the City of Atlanta. The venue is extraordinary, and we want to make sure as many people as possible have the opportunity to attend."

Weekend tickets for the Concours, which will be held on Oct. 19-20, will be reduced to \$55 this month, a

savings of \$30 from the normal ticket price. After April, the ticket price will increase.

The weekend offers visitors two days to view unique cars, with each day offering a different set of vehicles. On Sunday, however, visitors can experience the Concours competition, with dozens of rare cars from 1900 to 1968 on display at the former Fort McPherson site.

"The reason you come to this event," Walleit said, "is to see cars you have never seen before. And the cars that we have, we will have a large percentage of them with values in excess of a million dollars. Some of these cars are the only one left of their type."

RM Sotheby's Amelia Island Behind the scenes tour

Ramsey Potts was kind enough to give the Jaguar clubs a behind the scenes tour of the auction at Amelia Island. It was both informative and interesting. We had people from the clubs in South Carolina, North Carolina, Georgia, Pennsylvania, and several of the Florida clubs.

One of the major market driving influences in price is the dynamics of the aging process. We all know some people can collect or buy their dream cars from a very young age. Those of us who can't usually have to wait until later in life when the children are raised, educated and gone!!! This means the poster car we had on the wall as a teenager is not a reality until we get older.

One example at this year's auction was a 1994 Toyota Supra. Who would have believed this car would even be at an auction as exclusive as the one at Amelia Island.

It sold for \$173,600.00 including buyer's premium. That sure is one of the "if only's" in life.

Also, it was interesting to see the differences in the auction venues. Ramsey explained the Amelia Island

auction vehicles would average around \$450,000 (I may not have that exactly right). Therefore a \$25,000 car is not a good fit with the clientele at this venue. However, the Fort Lauderdale auction could average \$75,000.00

per vehicle. This is not to say there couldn't be million dollars plus vehicles at both auctions, but the demographic of the bidders is going to be different.

Ramsey reviewed several vehicles on the grounds including a Series III E-Type. He mentioned the Series III seems to have finally arrived as the earlier models have increased in price. This, of course, happens to a wide range of vehicles. People must continually move to different models and makes as they get priced out of the market. I am still hoping this happens to my XJS.

Jaguar Land Rover Could Use Ultraviolet Light To Kill Germs In Your Car

The UV-C technology is already in use by hospitals.

According to Jaguar Land Rover, the average driver spends 300 hours a year behind the wheel. That's a lot of time in which, the company says, your car could be doing more to keep you healthy. To that end, future Jaguar and Land Rover models could use special ultraviolet light -- UV-C light -- in order to kill germs before they get through the car's ventilation system.

The UV-C technology, which uses ultraviolet light in the 200-280-nanometer wavelengths, has been used in the medical field to sterilize surfaces and air by neutralizing bacteria and other pathogens. JLR's idea is to integrate this into the many hidden vents and ducts inside your car's dashboard, so the air that gets blown into the cabin has already been sterilized. Some JLR models already use air

ionization tech in their climate-control systems, but the UV-C system would be more effective.

JLR says the technology could prevent the spread of common colds and flus, but also says that studies show UV-C technology can cut the transmission of drug-resistant superbugs, including MRSA, VRE, C.

difficile and Acinetobacter, by 30 percent. All told, a car equipped with the technology could keep its occupants a whole lot more protected from illness-causing bugs.

The research comes as JLR investigates how the car of the future might change to become a more lounge-like experience or a shared ride-hailing vehicle once autonomous driving catches on. The last thing you want when hopping into a self-driving shuttle is to breathe in the last passenger's germs.

"The implementation of individual wellbeing measures as part of our 'tranquil sanctuary' research promises to not only improve quality of life for our customers but in this case, offers clear advantages in reducing pathogen spread -- protecting the overall population from the threat of disease, particularly as we move towards shared mobility solutions," Steve Iley, JLR chief medical officer, said in a statement.



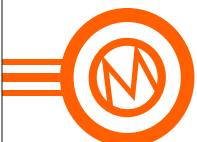
