Jaguar Special Operations announced that it has purchased Dr. James Hull's entire 543 classic British car collection. The collection was assembled over many years by British enthusiast James Hull, and includes 543 mostly British classic cars and features many significant Jaguar models. Among these cars are 130 Jags. These include early Swallow Sidecars and Swallow coachbuilt Austin Sevens, plus a full and diverse range of pre-war SS models, 7 XK 120s - including a rare alloy-bodied example, C- and D-types, an XKSS, 8 E-types, 30 classic Jaguar 'Mark' model saloons

plus 19 XJS models and over 20 XJ saloons with interesting and famous previous owners.

The majority of these cars are in truly outstanding condition considering many are pushing well over 60 years, with many having fascinating histories behind them.
