Jaguar XE SV Project 8

So what is Jaguar's XE SV PROJECT 8 you ask. Seems Jaguar is up to its old tricks of building blindingly fast limited production supercars. Remember the Jaguar XJ220 supercar from 1992? Well this is the modern version. The limited information on the web lists two choices; a four door sedan and a two door coupe. Both are hand built and feature a 600 HP Supercharged V8 and all-wheel drive...Jaguar's "...most powerful road-legal road car in history."

How fast you ask? The prototype set the fastest time ever recorded for a four door sedan around German's famous Nurburgring Nordschleife; a time faster than many well known supercars including the new mid-engine 'vette.

With worldwide production set at 300 left-hand examples, what are the chances of ever seeing one of these exciting Jaguars on the prowl? Well, quite excellent as it turns out. Club member Ken Hussey just text me the pictures of his...a beautiful four door burnt orange with gray stripes (check out the pictures of these cars on the web and take the video tour as the incredible XE SV Cat growls around the "Ring". Test rides anyone?



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Shooting Brake: the practical F-Type?

Earlier this month, Jaguar updated the F-Type, its stylish two-door sports car, for the 2021 model year. It wasn't a complete redesign. Instead, the automaker refreshed the car's exterior bodywork, improved interior ergonomics, and rejiggered the top-tier car's powertrains. X-Tomi Design decided to take the car's new look and extend the coupe's roof, turning the new F-Type into a gorgeous shooting brake.

The F-Type's new styling makes the car look longer and lower than before, and the longer roof helps accentuate those proportions. One change Jaguar made to the car's styling is reorienting the headlights horizontally. Before, Jaguar positioned them vertically along the front, reaching over the front wheels. The horizontal headlights widen the front-end design.

We can't see the Jaguar's rear-end design, though changes are far subtler at the rear compared to the car's previous design.

The F-Type shooting brake, if Jaguar were ever to make such a creation, which it won't, would gain a ton of functionality with the taller roof – the cargo

space could be cavernous. The longer roof also doesn't hinder the F-Type's smoothed design, especially over the rear fenders.

With the redesign, Jaguar tweaked the powertrain lineup. While the turbocharged 2.0-liter and supercharged V6 carry over unchanged, the supercharged 5.0-liter V8 saw improvements. With the SVR model tossed in the dustbin of history, the range-topping F-Type R now makes 575 horsepower (429 kilowatts) and 516 pound-feet (700 Newton-meters) of torque. It's capable of rocketing the Jaguar to 60 miles per hour (96 kilometers per hour) in 3.5 seconds. A shooting brake would be a few tenths slower with the added weight.

A Jaguar F-Type shooting brake is unlikely to happen. For one, the business case for such a model is thin, and it'd sell in limited quantities just like the current F-Type coupe and F-Type convertible. If anything, the Jaguar F-Type shooting brake is nothing but a tease.



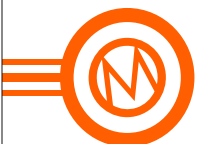
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Replacement ignition and door keys for Jaguar cars

Triple-C.com tries to keep a stock of original Union/Wilmot Breeden FNR keys, for early XK vehicles along with FS, FP for some later cars.

If your are looking for 1990-1997 model Jaguar car keys using high security keys such as "Tibbe" they can help - they specialized key cutting equipment will cut 8 cut Tibbe keys. These are good through to 1997 (some cars in some markets were earrier).
