VISIT TO WOLF WINERY JULY 18

Please note that our lunch time for this event has been changed to approximately 12 noon. We currently have about twenty people signed up for this visit. We can accommodate more if others decide to attend but we must give the winery a final count by about July 11 or 12. The lunch is served buffet style and the cost per person is approximately \$25. The winery is located on the top of a hill and has an impressive view of the surrounding countryside from the dining room and porch.

The plan is to meet at 10:30AM at the BB&T Bank which is at the corner of West Main and Waters St. in Dahlonega. This is about a block off the town square in the direction of Elijah—if you come into town from GA 400, go to the town square and turn left (you may have to circle the town square to go in this direction). Dave Kirkman has planned a short 30-40 minute (20 mile) backroad drive to the winery—we'll depart at 10:45AM. There are several options for the afternoon. A tour of the winery is included in the price of the meal. Dahlonega is a charming small mountain town and is worth exploring on foot. For those of you who desire a longer drive, Dave has outlined a longer drive for the afternoon and will provide maps. If you plan to attend, please notify Roy Cleveland by July 12 (Monday). If you plan to attend the lunch but won't be participating in the drive beforehand, the directions to the winery are included below.

Directions to Wolf Mountain Winery:

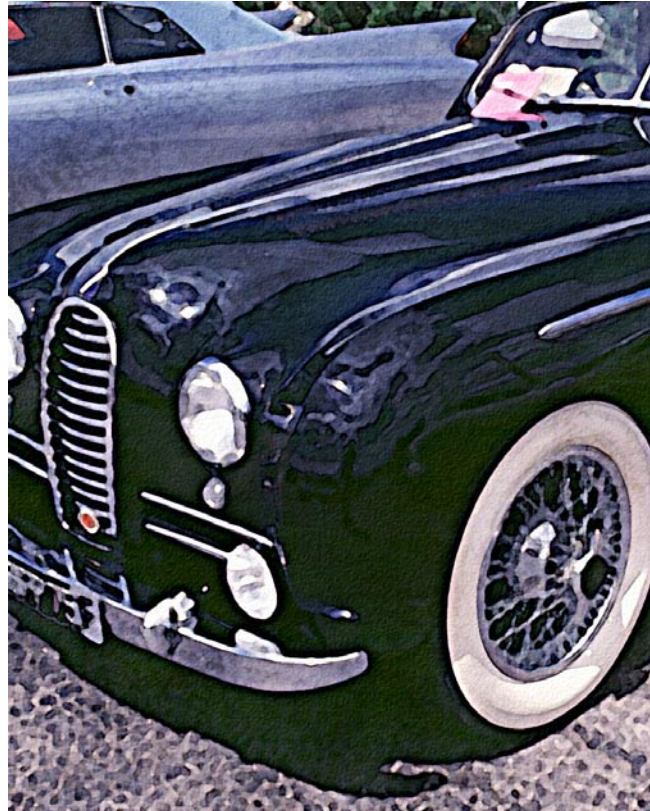
Follow GA 400 North until it ends. Turn left on Hwy. 60 North. Continue 5 miles to the first stoplight. Turn right onto Hwy. 19/60 North bypass. Continue 4 miles and turn left onto Ridley Road. After one-half mile, turn left on Wolf Mountain Trail.

Jaguar Enthusiasts' Club Members Tour USA

In October of this year a group of JEC members are visiting the US and they are shipping their cars over to use while they are here. Currently they are planning to bring about 55 cars (12 XKs, 18 E-Types and a variety of others new and old). They will fly into Houston and drive up through Mississippi to Memphis,

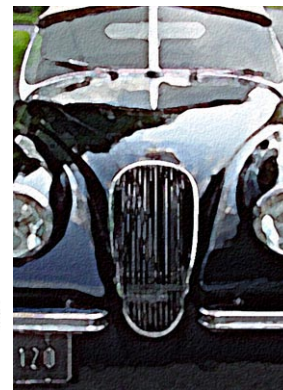

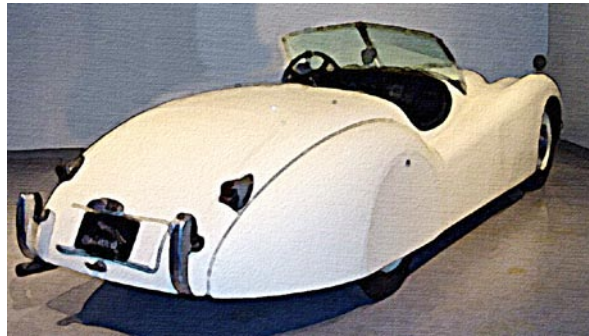


Concours d'Elegance – Chattahoochee Country Club – September 26, 2004

The Club's 2004 Concours d'Elegance will be held September 26, 2004 at the Chattahoochee Country Club in Gainesville, Georgia. This is one of the biggest events which we have each year. Last year, we had over 40 Jaguars. The objective is to have a delicious brunch with fellow enthusiasts in a pleasant setting and to enjoy looking at beautiful Jaguars. This can happen only if you and your Jaguar are there; so dust off your cat and plan to attend. Your car does not have to be perfect for you to attend. In fact, it adds to the day if there are cars in varying conditions on hand. If you register for "Display Only," everyone can enjoy seeing your car without it having to be judged. The Chattahoochee Country Club is located on Lake Lanier just off Highway 60 which connects Gainesville and Dahlonega. For more information about the club see www.chattahoocheecountryclub.com.

We have arranged for a site convenient to the main clubhouse to

be reserved exclusively for our use. There is a large covered pavilion next to the club swimming pool and adjacent to the car display area where members and entrants may relax in the shade. This area also will be reserved for our exclusive use on that day. A brunch (sponsored by Hennessy Jaguar) will be available in the clubhouse for our members and concours entrants. A private dining room facing the lake has been reserved for our use. The brunch will include the usual array of brunch type dishes as well as beverages and dessert. Please note that for NGJC and JCNA members, if you bring a Jaguar and



enter it or display it, you will be entitled to two free brunches per car (up to three cars). The brunch charge for additional guests is \$23 including taxes and gratuity. If you are unable to bring a Jaguar, you are welcome to attend and have brunch but you must fill out a registration form and pay for brunch. You will notice on the registration form there is a slight discount for registering before August 30.

This will be an officially sanctioned JCNA event and scores will count toward national standings. JCNA rules will be followed; therefore, there will be a Champion Division and a Driven Division.

Registration fees are detailed in the registration form which is included in this newsletter. Volunteers are needed to tally scoring sheets and to help with some other duties. If you are willing to volunteer, please call.
