## JUNE 28-29 DRIVING EVENT OVERNIGHT IN GATLINBURG

The Ramada Inn Four Seasons in Gatlinburg (800) 933-8678 agreed to hold a block of fifteen rooms for us until May 28 so by the time you read this those rooms probably will have been released but if you want to make the trip, call and check availability.

The general plan for the weekend is to meet in the locations indicated below and have lunch in or near Clayton, GA around noon. After lunch we will travel to Franklin, NC and tour the Scottish Tartans museum, which has the largest data base of tartans outside of Scotland ([www.scottishtartans.org](http://www.scottishtartans.org)). Some members of the Smoky Mountain Jaguar Club may meet up with us there. Then we will motor on following Hwy. 441 over the mountain to Gatlinburg. As we pass through Newfound Gap we'll be near Clingman's Dome which was voted one of the 10 most beautiful places in America by the editors of USA WEEKEND Magazine recently. We'll stay overnight in Gatlinburg and after breakfast there on Sunday, we will leave and travel the Foothills Parkway to Hwy. 129 south through Deals Gap. This area boasts of 318 curves in 11 miles. On the NC side of Hwy. 129, we'll venture onto Hwy. 28 by Lake Fontana and back into Franklin where we'll have lunch. From there we'll follow our separate ways back home. This promises to be a fun weekend with some great driving roads and beautiful scenery. We hope to see you there.
