

### JCNA CONCOURS **RULES CHANGES**

A number of changes were to the JCNA Concours rules at this years Annual General Membership Meeting (AGM). XJS model classes are now split with 1976-91 in one class and 1992-96 in another. The Mechanical Inspection is now called Operation Verification and has its own, new separate shore sheet. The Primary Judging team will be allowed an additional 5 minutes for the inspection and entrants are now allowed 15 minutes of "courtesy repair time" to correct any malfunctions found during the inspection. The score sheets have also been reformatted to include a section where the judge must indicate the location of major deductions.
