The Monte Carlo style rally is the "fun way to rally". The driver and navigator receive instructions with a starting point and a destination (checkpoint) and a series of strip maps showing roads and distances to choose from between the two points. The object is to arrive at the checkpoint in the stated time in the instructions. It is

up to the driver and navigator to select the roads and follow them on the strip maps. A stop watch, or the stop watch function on your cell phone, is all that is required to keep track of the running time as you travel from the start to the checkpoint.


There were club members from VA, NC, SC, GA,




