During this time of Covid, several members have expressed concerns about attending our Judges Training on August 15th. Paul Immerman and Ellen Meshnick reached out and suggested we offer our training on Zoom as well as in person. For the first time, and with their invaluable guidance, we can offer training both in person as well as on Zoom. Mute yourself when you aren't actively talking

In order to streamline the training, I ask all those who want to participate to make themselves familiar with what is required to know and complete the test prior to the 15th. This should take approximately 1-2 hours to complete. Here is what you will need to do:

1. Go to the JCNA website Concourse page. The rules are listed on the first page as "Chapters I – VI"

and "Appendix A – E."

- 2. Review the "Judge Refresher Training Power Point Presentation (AUG 17)."
- 3. Print the "2019 Judge Blank Answer Sheet;" it's on the same line as the "Judge Test."
- Click on the "2019 Judge Test." Please note, every question contains the Chapter and Page Number where the answer can be found.
- 5. Place your answers on the "2019 Judge Blank Answer Sheet."
- Be sure to enter your information at the top of the answer sheet. Note: Our region is SE and our club number is 57.
- Scan your answer sheet and email it to jaguar@ georgiaexpo.com or mail it to Philip DiTrolio – 4825 Kettle River Pt. – Suwanee, GA 30024.

If you're attending the training in person, you can also bring your completed answer sheet with you; if not return your answer sheet prior to the training date so we can promptly submit them to the JCNA for certification.

If you would like to attend the training in person, we will be meeting at Georgia Expo- 3355 Martin Farm Rd.- Suwanee, GA 30024 @ 10:00 AM. Lunch will be catered.

In addition to the training, we are planning on having several members' Jaguars inside our warehouse so we can sample judge the cars. So far, we have a couple of E Types, XK8s, and an XJ. We would still like to have other models available, XK 120 - 140, etc.

If everyone completes their test prior to August 15th, the review should take fewer than 2 hours, and then we can get to the fun part: playing with our cars!



As previously stated, cars will be judged and awards given in Championship and Driven Divisions, but Display only cars are especially urged to attend! Due to




Jaguar Design Masterclass Offers a Tour of I-PACE Development

Hosted by Jaguar designers, the four-part series follows the all-electric Jaguar I-PACE through the initial design stages.

Jaguar is giving insight into its design process with a series of masterclass films produced to encourage creativity and skills development at home. Hosted by Jaguar designers, the four-part series follows the progress of the all-electric Jaguar I-PACE through the initial design stages, with expert advice and tips from each of the disciplines featured in the films.


Just like in the design studio, the process begins with sketching. Chief Creative Designer Dominic



The third film follows Chris Scholes, Senior Alias Modeller as he creates an exterior design proposal, taking the 2D digital render and developing it into 3D surfaces using Autodesk Alias software. Finally, CG Artist Elliot Brett from the Design Visualization team brings the I-PACE to life, detailing how it is taken from storyboard through to animation. All four films are available to view now starting with Episode 1:

Najafi gives a tutorial on sketching the I-PACE with a pencil and paper before handing over to Matthew Beaven, Chief Exterior Designer, who then transforms the preliminary sketch idea into a professional digital render using Photoshop.
