Please take a moment and write that check now for your 2013 NGJC membership dues so we can spend our energy on improving the club experience rather than issuing constant reminders for payment. If you know you are not renewing, a short email to John Baxa or Roy Cleveland with your intentions would be appreciated. The dues for NGJC are \$51 and are due by January 1st. This is the first increase in our club dues in several years, primarily in response to an increase in the portion that goes to the JCNA national organization. In fact, the national portion went up \$8.00 this year and our local board of directors decided to increase the total amount by only \$4.00 per year thanks, in part, to the good financial position our local club enjoys.






2012 Hilton Head Car Club Jamboree

QR Code (abbreviated from Quick Response Code) is the trademark for a type of matrix barcode first designed for the automotive industry. More recently, the system has become popular outside the industry due to its fast readability and large storage capacity compared to standard UPC barcodes. The code consists of black modules (square dots) arranged in a square pattern on a white background. With a smart phone app. you can scan and link directly to our NGJC website.
