It was created to serve as a charitable arm of our clubs to preserve the heritage of our hobby and to promote the continued education of amateur and professional Jaguar preservation and restoration. The Foundation has a vision of funding scholarships for the education of tomorrow's automobile restorers as well as establishing a repository of Jaguar classic cars, memorabilia, and literature. This is a collective effort where all contributions, small and large, are needed and appreciated.

Building A Solid Foundation

Just a couple of years ago the Jaguar Foundation was created to fulfill the need for a charitable organization dedicated to the preservation of the Jaguar automobile heritage in North America. Already the Foundation has acquired historical artifacts, automobiles and tools in pursuit of its mission. In the future there will be scholarships for students to learn the art of automotive restoration, as well as a permanent site to store and display the growing collection of historical material. There have been recent additionis to our collection which include a clean 1956 XK140C, a Jaguar model car collection numbering over 1500 pieces and a

In addition to growth, there has been change. The name of the Foundation will soon change from the Jaguar Foundation to the Coventry Foundation.

The Coventry Foundation is an independent 501c3 organization, not related to either the Jagar Clubs of North America nor to Jaguar Land Rover Limited.


Dr. Ralf Speth, Jaguar Land Rover (JLR) CEO, accepted the Golden Steering Wheel for the Jaguar XF.

Billie Leonard and I recently took my 1961 E-Type #006 to the Trump Charlotte Concours. This was held just a few days after the election in November. Eric Trump has a foundation benefiting St. Jude's Children's Hospital and this event is their largest fundraiser. It was a beautiful location at the Trump Charlotte Golf Club and I received Best in Class, making it even nicer.

As Giancarlo, a participant with a Fiat entry said, "I was entered with 9 other cars in the "European Production" class, one of about I'd say 100 cars total. A good turnout for a new event, (2nd annual) and this number did not include other display vehicles that were not in the formal concours. I did not particularly like the judging

format, where basically each show entrant voted on the best car in their class that was not their own. The most tabulated first place votes got 1st, 2nd most got 2nd, and so on. I'd hope next year they hire an actual concours judge or judges to grade the thing, but the event was small with a relaxed atmosphere and for charity so this can be forgiven, you want to keep costs down so I can understand. I didn't win anything (hard to compete with a Fiat against a 1961 Jaguar E-Type, the 6th built...and a very nice 1956 Jaguar XK120 Coupe) but met some nice people, made a new friend, and had the best damn buffet dinner in my life on Saturday night, a fact my table-mates were in universal agreement on."

One of the more interesting cars on display was the 1965 Brawner Hawk racer. This car was built by future IndyCar legends Clint Brawner and Jim McGee for a young driver to use at his Brickyard debut. That driver was Mario Andretti. The seat was originally offered to Roger Penske, but he turned down the opportunity to focus on his various business interests.

Andretti not only passed his rookie test in this car, he also finished 3rd in that year's Indy 500. Later that same year, he won his first Indy Car race in the Hawk on the road course at Indianapolis Raceway Park and went on to win the 1965 USAC championship.



Added JCNA Member Benefit Discount on New Jaguars to JCNA Members

The operation of the plan is simple. First go through the normal purchase procedure at the dealership. Then show your JCNA membership card and dealer will apply the discount. Jaguar will take care of crediting the dealer.
