


Sunday afternoon January 11th found better than two dozen of our membership eyeing a profound collection of mostly Chevrolets courtesy of Jim Gebhardt of Roswell, owner of California Car Company on Alpharetta Highway in Roswell. Thanks to Jim's hospitality we had an opportunity to examine a collection that was a little more focused than many we have seen as his interest in particular is toward mid-50s Chevrolets of extremely low original mileage or low production numbers—some in original condition, some only lightly restored, some more so.



There were more cars than people, in fact 37 on the roster he handed out and you might wonder how he stores them in what looks like a normal garage from the street. Once the doors to the garage were opened, it became apparent; however, as you can see from the pictures—they were carefully parked using every available space, some appearing only an inch apart! It also helps to have a large garage on two levels.

Jim added a lot of detail about how various cars were acquired and some of the fantastically fortuitous circumstances made for good storytelling. This really added a lot to the observers' appreciation of the uniqueness of each auto. The heart of the collection are the 1955-57 models including Bel Airs, 210s, Del Rays, even a Sedan Delivery and a Nomad. Apart from this core group were mostly 60's models—Impalas, Malibus, Novas and a couple of newer cars including a 1997 Jaguar XK8 and a 2003 Thunderbird.

Jim also has other cars in other locations and has another company, Express Auto Body, a repair and restoration business on North Fulton Industrial Boulevard in Alpharetta. 


