

After a nourishing visit to Wallace's Barbecue to gather together participating members, we toured Streetside's facility just off Thornton Road. After a short introduction and explanation of their business model, Sales Manager Bob Mueller let us browse among the 100-plus vehicles at this location, one of two the company operates. The other one is in Charlotte and

Bob says they hope to expand perhaps within the next year or so, probably looking at the Dallas, Texas area. Bob explained the advantages of consigning your classic through their sales network rather than trying to sell a car yourself—chief among them not having to deal with potential customers on your own, taking advantage of their marketing infrastructure, and being able to list on web sites economically thanks to their advantages of scale. In fact, as of this writing, I was able to see more

than 60 listings of cars from their inventory on EBay. You can also visit their website to see their offerings--www.streetsideclassics.com. At present, the cars at their warehouse skew heavily in the American muscle car category, but there still is quite a variety of ages and types. Thanks go to George Haldane who set up this visit and who offered a testimonial, having sold his turquoise XJ-S through Streetside.



## If you are coming down I 85:

Continue through downtown Atlanta south on I-85 towards Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport. Right at Camp Creek Parkway Exit as you approach the airport exits.

Right on Camp Creek Parkway. Take Camp Creek Parkway approximately 3 miles and go under I-285. Continue on Camp Creek Parkway approximately .5 miles and 3800 Camp Creek Parkway will be on your left.


If you are coming down GA 400: Continue on GA 400 to merge with I-85 and follow I-85 directions to 3800 Camp Creek Parkway on your left OR:

If you are coming down I-75: Right on I-285 WEST (towards Birmingham) Continue on I-285 approximately 16 miles to Camp Creek Parkway (Camp Creek Parkway is approximately 7.5 miles after you go under I-20) Right at Camp Creek Parkway Exit Right on Camp Creek Parkway Continue on Camp Creek Parkway approximately .5 miles and 3800 Camp Creek Parkway will be on your left.
