JAGUAR CLUBS & EVENTS IN ENGLAND

Beginning with this issue, we are presenting a listing of selected Jaguar and classic car events scheduled in the U.S. and England.

There are two large Jaguar clubs in England. The oldest of these, of which I am a member, is the Jaguar Drivers Club (JDC). The JDC was formed in 1955 and has the distinction of once having Sir William Lyons, the founder of Jaguar Cars, as its president (1958). The other major club is the Jaguar Enthusiasts Club (JEC). Terry Hulsey, Joe Newell, and possibly some other NGJC members are also members of this club. We'll have some more information about the JEC in a subsequent newsletter.




FIG 1:1 The Jaguar XK engin

The JDC (website is www.jaguardriver.co.uk/) is subdivided into registers (XK, E-Type, XJ, etc.). A long-time friend of mine, Brian Davis, is the chairman of the XK Register. Cost for the weekend is 390 British pounds (about \$630) per couple. This includes two nights lodging, two dinners, two breakfasts, 1 lunch and all visits. 
