2013 JCNA Trophies To Local Members

Several NGJC members have earned trophies in national competition which will be awarded in the middle of March of this year. Roy and Linda Cleveland ranked 3rd place in Concours competition in Championship Class C04 showing their 1960 Indigo Blue XK-150 with an average score of 99.97667. Dick and Mary Lee Maury scored 9.99533 with their 1971 BR Green E-Type Fixed Head Coupe in the Special Division S03 for modified cars.

The other area of competition that our members compete in is the Slalom which we hold locally in the spring and fall. John Baxa earned 2nd place in the Early Sedans (large and small) Class in his 1961 Mark IX with a time of 54.036. Jim O'Dell took 1st place in the Modified Class with a time of 40.091 using Dick Maury's 1971 E-Type FHC getting past Dick's own 2nd place finish time of 40.659 in the same car.
