twenty-three trim selections and six engine options. I have a picture in my home office showing the entire 1949 - 1950 model range of the Jaguar. One model Mark V, in either drophead coupe or saloon. With a 2 ½ or 3 ½ litre engine. We have come a long way. I did not include, nor did the picture, the XK120, as it was a very limited production car in those years.

It gets even better. The I Pace was just unveiled with a release date of 2018. This is envisioned as a fantastic vehicle. It will have dual 200 HP electric engines, each with 259 ft. lbs. of torque, for a massive 400 HP and 516 ft. lbs. of torque, propelling the I Pace to 60 MPH in 4 seconds. The initial range will be 200-220 miles with recharging to 80% time of 90 minutes.

Not only will EV be on the consumer side but also in the all-electric Formula E racing series which debuted in the last three years. Jaguar's impending return to competition will be in this fall's Formula E World Championship. In 2018 the endurance of the E racing series cars battery life should be such that they will need only one car per race. At this time they actually change to another fully charged car mid race. This development should translate directly to the street version. We are hoping to have one of the primary engineers involved in this research at our JCNA IJF event in October.

Team director James Barclay said in a recent article, "Historically, Jaguar's always gone into racing to improve the breed. The C-Type was the first to employ disc brakes, and the aluminum structure and aerodynamics of racing D-Types also filtered into road-going cars. We could have chosen other forms of motorsports but ultimately, Formula E was the most compelling."

My News Years Resolution: Don't let them sit. Drive them, have fun and be safe.

Jaguar Unveils the 'New Original' XKSS

It may seem odd that an automaker is building new versions of an old car. But for Jaguar, this is to button up some unfinished business.

From 1954 to 1956, Jaguar built the XKSS. This was the road-going version of the famed D-Type racecar, which cemented Jaguar's reputation for racing as it would win the famed Le Mans race in '55 and '56. The company was planning to build nine models in 1957, but a fire at the Browns Lane factory destroyed the vehicles destined for North America. As a result, only 16 XKSS models were built.

In November at the LA Auto Show, Jaguar Classic unveiled a one-off prototype of the 'New Original' XKSS. This vehicle took 18 months for the team to research and build it. Jaguar Classic used the original blueprints along with digital scans of XKSS models to get it right. The prototype is powered by the D-Type's 3.4L straight-six producing 262 horsepower. The engine boasts new cast iron blocks, new cast cylinder heads, and three Weber DC03 carburetors. Plus it can run on unleaded fuel.

Jaguar will be building the remaining nine vehicles using the period-correct chassis numbers from the original XKSS ledger. The magnesium alloy bodies will be handcrafted on a new, bespoke styling buck.

How much will one of these set you back? Over a million dollars. But before you start checking your bank account, the nine vehicles have already been sold.



Jaguar I-Pace Concept Shows An Electrifying Future From News Reports

A number of luxury manufacturers are busy working on developing electric vehicles, partly due to the success Tesla is experiencing. Last October in Los Angeles, Jaguar introduced their vision for an electric vehicle.

This is the I-Pace concept and it previews an electric crossover that will be going on sale in

2018. The big story is underneath the I-Pace's sleek sheet metal. This concept isn't riding on the same platform as the F-Pace crossover. Instead, the I-Pace debuts a new dedicated



architecture which the automaker says allows their designers and engineers to rip apart the rules on vehicle layout. For example, the 90 kWh lithium-ion battery pack resides underneath the floor of the cabin. This allowed designers to maximize interior space. Open the rear tailgate and you'll find a flat load area offering 18.7 cubic feet of space.

The battery pack offers a maximum range of 220 miles. While that's under the 250 mile range of the Model X - the model that the I-Pace will be compared to - the 220 mile range is nothing to complain about. Continued on page 5





Power comes from two electric motors, one mounted in each axle with 200 horsepower and 258 pound-feet of torque. Total output stands at 400 hp and 516 lb-ft of torque. Jaguar says the I-Pace can hit 60 mph in 4 seconds.

Back to the sheet metal. Jaguar's designers pulled a number of cues from the C-X75 supercar concept from 2010 such as heavily sculpted hood and raked windshield. The lack of an engine and transmission also allowed Jaguar designers to employ cabforward design, allowing them to increase interior space and shorten the front and rear overhangs. At certain angles, the I-Pace looks like a crossover. At others, it looks like a hatchback.

The interior looks "concept-esq" with slim seats and a large number of screens. But there are certain details that will likely make it into the production model such




as a steering wheel with new touch-style switches. A panoramic sunroof increases the overall feeling of space.

online, something that Tesla has been doing for awhile. The production version of the I-Pace concept will


