

VISIT TO WOLF WINERY JULY 18

Please note that our lunch time for this event has been changed to approximately 12 noon. We currently have about twenty people signed up for this visit. We can accommodate more if others decide to attend but we must give

the winery a final count by about July 11 or 12. The lunch is served buffet style and the cost per person is approximately \$25. The winery is located on the top of a hill and has an impressive view of the surrounding countryside from the dining room and porch.

The plan is to meet at 10:30AM at the BB&T Bank which is at the corner of West Main and Waters St. in Dahlonega. This is about a block off the town square in the direction of Ellijay—if you come into town from GA 400. go to the town square and turn left (you may have to circle the town square to go in this direction). Dave Kirkman has planned a short 30-40 minute (20 mile) backroad drive to the winery—we'll depart at 10:45AM. There are several options for the afternoon. A tour of the winery is included in the price of the meal. Dahlonega is a charming small mountain town and is worth exploring on foot. For those of you who desire a longer drive, Dave has outlined a longer drive for the afternoon and will provide maps. If you plan to attend, please notify Roy Cleveland by July 12 (Monday). 
won't be participating in the drive beforehand, the directions to the winerv are included below. **Directions to Wolf Mountain Winery:**


