Beer, wine, and mixed drinks are available in the dining room, bar or on the patio. **Events:**

For Thursday evening we have planned a cook out, the great all-you-can-eat Seafood Extravaganza for Friday, and a prime rib or shitake chicken dinner for Saturday night's award banquet. You must prepay for these on your registration form. All drinks are from the cash bar. The dining room at the Inn will be open for breakfast and lunch each day.




