

Saturday Tech Session on Tires Well Attended



Thanks also go to Ivan and Myrna Ruiz as they organized the event and let Dennis use their XK8 to demonstrate how an alignment is done with computerized equipment which included color printouts both before and after showing where the problem spots were and how they were corrected. We also got to see how the tire balancing process is performed with the use of new 3M custom-cut weights with adhesive

backing applied to wheels in place of lead weights in an effort to reduce the environmental impact of traditional lead weights.

After the presentation we had lunch at the Paper Mill Grill down the street with about 30-plus in attendance.

a wooden model and then an aluminum streamlined body on aircraft tubing. The car was 17 1/2 feet long with a 117 inch wheelbase, 56-inch thread, and a weight of 2500 pounds. Norman's streamliner was powered by a 1948 Buick Straight 8 engine located just behind the driver's seat. Total cost of the build was \$10,000 according to Mechanix Illustrated in September 1949.

Completed in 1948, Norman's Buick Special was featured in an episode of Buck Rogers. For several years the car was parked away in the hot California desert. In 2000 the car was featured in the Nicholas Cage movie Gone in 60 Seconds. Two years later, in 2002 it was auctioned away by Barret-Jackson at the Peterson Museum Classic Car Auction for a sales price of \$17,600.00. Collector Gary Cerveny was the lucky bidder. Gary began to restore the car before he handed it over to Custom Auto of Loveland, Colorado to let them complete it. Before Gary handed the car over he repaired the wheel wells, grill opening and drive train. The car was about 90% original when Gary acquired the car. The body halves had been bolted together, and access holes had been cut in for the rear wheels and the engine bay.

Also, racing legends Richard "The King" Petty, Sir Stirling Moss OBE and Don "Big Daddy" Garlits will come together to participate in what should prove to be an unpredictable and exciting seminar on Saturday, March 13, at the Ritz-Carlton, the host hotel.

With his trademark cowboy hat and sunglasses, Richard "The King" Petty, as he is nicknamed, is widely considered to be the greatest NASCAR driver of all time and his impact on motorsports can outstrip the glory of any one of his victory lanes. In addition to his appearance at the Saturday Seminar, this NASCAR legend will serve as the key note speaker at the Concours' annual Gala Dinner Saturday, March 13.

Don Garlits, widely considered as the father of drag racing, was the first driver to win three National Hot Rod Association national titles and three world championships. Always a pioneer in the field of dragracing, he, with the help of T.C. Lemons, perfected the rear-engine "top fuel dragster design".

Moss, who raced from 1948 to 1962, won 194 of the 497 races he entered, including 16 Formula

One Grands Prix. Moss was a pioneer in the British Formula One racing scene and placed second in the Drivers' Championship four times in a row from 1955 to 1958. He is often described as the finest road racer of all time. One of his most famous victories was in the

Mercedes-Benz 300SLR in the 1955 Mille Miglia, in which he won in a record time of 10 hours, 7 minutes, and 48 seconds, finishing almost half hour ahead of his teammate. Details on the events are at www. ameliaconcours.org
