New Website For Apparel and Merchandise

With the additional features implemented on the club website prior to the IJF, we can now handle the apparel/regalia orders at www.ngjc.us. This allows us to cancel the dedicated apparel/regalia website and will save the club several hundred dollars annually.

We have also added postage and handling to the cost of the items so that we may mail the item when picked up from the supplier. This has been averaged so that a flat fee is included in the pricing. We will monitor to make sure we are charging the correct fee.

You may order items at any time during the month. These individual orders will be accumulated, and an order placed with the supplier at the end of each month. It normally takes a week to 10 days for the order to be ready for pick up. Therefore, an order placed in the month of March will not be received

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Daniel Craig's Aston Martin Vanquish Heads To Charity Auction

Daniel Craig will give up the keys to his personal 2014 Aston Martin Vanquish Centenary Edition when it heads to auction at The Exceptional Sale at Christie's in New York.

Fittingly, the 2014 Vanquish is serial number 007—Craig is the most recent individual to portray James Bond, 007—and the actor worked with Aston Martin to fully personalize the car. Craig's affinity for denim and dark blue hues led to the custom midnight-blue exterior and deep blue, hand-stitched, leather interior. The interior also features a swath of carbon fiber and aluminum accents.

Aston Martin built 100 examples of the Centenary Edition Vanquish to celebrate the company's 100th anniversary, and each features the familiar 6.0-liter V-12 paired to an automatic transmission.

Proceeds from the sale of Craig's Vanquish

will exclusively benefit The Opportunity Network, which is a non-profit organization that provides young people with pathways to career development.

"While I will miss it, I am keen to further the very important work of The Opportunity Network with its sale," Craig said in the auction announcement.

The car will cross the auction block at The Exceptional Sale on April 20, where it's estimated to fetch between \$400,000 and \$600,000. It doesn't get much closer than this to own James Bond's personal car. Just make sure not to touch the buttons marked "drop oil" or "launch rockets" should you get the chance to sit in the car.

As you know, the conference center is where the 2018 concours will be held, conveniently located next to the host hotel...'Four Points by Sheraton''. Speaking of the hotel...keep in mind, the cut-off date for room reservations is March 24th.

Definition of Divisions and Check Points to be Judged

Champion Division - It challenges its Entrants to research, prepare, and present the judged portions of their cars in their original, authentic, factory-delivered configuration, and condition. All Entries in Champion Division will have their interiors, exteriors, engine compartments, and boots judged for authenticity, condition, and cleanliness.

Driven Division - Present their Entries in their original, authentic, factorydelivered configuration and condition. Driven Division is for Jaguars that, regardless of age, are in regular use. In consideration of this usage, Driven Division Entries do not have their engine compartments or boots judged and certain convenience and safety related authenticity exceptions are allowed. The exteriors and interiors of Driven Division Entries are judged to the same standard as Champion Division. *Display Division* - Display entries are not formally judged, scored or given any competition points. For record purposes, member Display Entrants must be included when reporting concours results on the JCNA Competition Results web page, with the annotation "Display" in the Class field *Special Division* - Special Division is intended for factory and non-factoryprepared competition and limited production Jaguars; production Jaguars privately prepared for competition; modified production Jaguars, and Jaguar powered vehicles with replica Jaguar bodies. The interior, exterior, engine compartment, and boot of Special Division Entries are judged only for condition and cleanliness, NOT for authenticity.

S1/PD Note 1: Factory-produced and prepared Competition Jaguars, Factory Sponsored Competition and Limited Production Jaguars. Note 2: Production Jaguars privately prepared and modified for competition S2/MOD Note 3: Modified.

S3/REP Note 4: Replica (non-production, Jaguar powered).

Preservation Class - Preservation Class is for unrestored or near original Entries over 20 years old, well prepared, and in good to excellent condition. Class entry is to be the Entrant's choice. Preservation Class Entries shall be judged as all other Champion Division Entries, that is, based on authenticity, condition, and cleanliness, except, restored or reconditioned assessed "non-authentic, wrong, missing, or incorrect" point deductions.

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US Demand for British Built Cars Increases

From Just British the Online Motoring Magazine

American demand for British-built cars rose in 2017, as increasing popularity of the UK's ever-growing range of premium, luxury and sports cars, helped drive UK automotive exports to the country. Latest figures published today by the Society of Motor Manufacturers and Traders (SMMT), show almost 210,000 US buyers chose a UK-made car last year, an uplift of 7.0%.

A total of 1,671,166 vehicles rolled off UK production lines in 2017, a -3.0% decrease on 2016 – but still the second highest output since the turn of the century. Export demand from 160 markets worldwide now represents 79.9% of all UK car output – the highest proportion for five years.

The EU remained the UK's biggest trading partner, taking more than half (53.9%) of all exports, while global appetite for British-built cars rose in several key markets. Among those showing notable growth were Japan (+25.4%), China (+19.7%) and Canada (+19.5%).

Note: Honda may be Japanese, but the new 10th generation Civic is, in fact, an all-British affair.

Not only is this striking new five-seater hatchback built in Swindon for the British market, the plant also supplies the U.S., Europe and even Japan.

However, the US remained the UK's biggest individual customer, with American drivers buying more British-built cars than those in any other single country. In 2017, 209,946 cars left British production lines destined for US roads, with the country boosting its share of UK exports to 15.7% - up from 14.5% in 2016. Meanwhile, in the UK, 34,868 British buyers invested in cars from American

factories, representing 1.3% of the UK new car market.

The UK's reputation as a center for excellence in engine design and manufacture was also boosted in 2017, as billions of pounds of investment helped drive production to record levels, with demand for British-built engines growing at home and overseas. Overall UK engine output rose 6.9% to more than 2.7 million units – with 54.7% destined for car and van plants around the world. In fact, the UK exports some £7.9 billion worth of components each year to help build vehicles in the US. The Society of Motor Manufacturers and Traders (SMMT) is one of the largest and most influential trade associations in the UK. It supports the interests of the UK automotive industry at home and abroad, promoting a united position to government, stakeholders and the media.
