Drive Friendly, Dave K. The short answer is: It can be. Linda and I bought our 1994 XJ12 in 1999 to be her daily driver. We were the third owners but it had only 38,000 miles (under 8000

m/yr).

It sold new for \$80,000.00 (it's a 12 cylinder!). We paid \$21,598 including the remaining extended warranty purchased by the 2nd owner at the Jaguar dealer as a select edition used car. Now a 12 cylinder is not your typical economical daily driver, but after incurring some recent expenses, I decided to see just what it has cost us over the past 14.7 years through the end of 2013. Yes, I do keep records.

The expenses following include everything but gasoline. It includes tires and oil changes that would occur with any vehicle and maybe should not be included, but they are. Premium gasoline averaged less than \$1000 per year.

Total expenses were \$20,674 or \$1406/year or \$117 per month. The range of expenses was zero in 2005 to \$5945 in 2008. The past 4 years were under \$1000 per year.

If you add what we paid, less its current value (insured by Hagerty for \$10,000), you would find the car cost us \$2195/year or \$183/month. All things considered, that's a pretty reasonable result. It works out to 48 cents per mile, a little high as we only averaged under 5000 miles per year. It is still somewhat reasonable for the use and pleasure of driving a luxury Jaguar; and after 15 years it's still Linda's daily driver.
