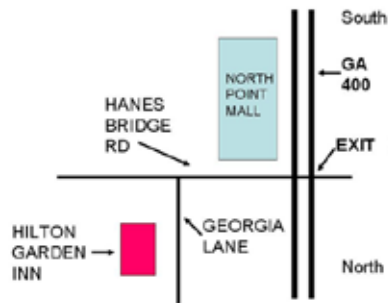

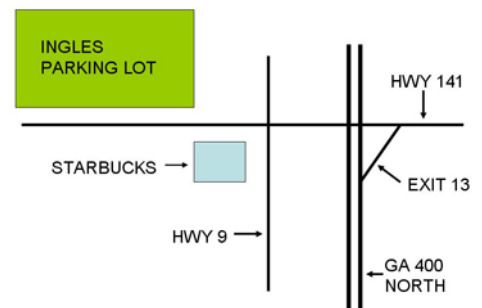

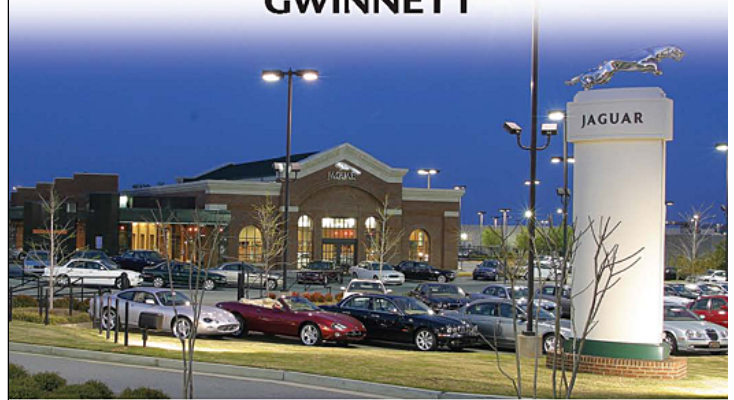

### Added JCNA Member Benefit Discount on New Jaguars to JCNA Members
