

The North Georgia Jaguar Club held its largest Concours d'Elegance ever this Fall with over 67 Jaguars gracing the shores of beautiful Lake Lanier just outside of Atlanta. Host club of the 2005 Challenge Championship and home club of our JCNA President, the NGJC wanted to do something special this year to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the E-Type. They did just that with over 25 of these beauties on display to include two very special Series 1 cars...



PROPOSED CHANGES TO NGJC BY-LAWS OCT. 23, 2011

- 1. Revise Article III, Section 1 to delete Vice-President for Concours and add Vice-President for Activities.
- Revise Article III, to replace current Section 9 with the Section 9 as included in the original by-laws of the club which provided for a Vice-President for Activities and defined its duties.
- 3. Revise Article III, Section 5 to read the same as the original by-laws. This would remove all responsibilities for activities from the Vice-President. They are included in the duties of the Vice-President for Activities in the new Section 9 described above. Also, the responsibilities of the Vice-President of Concours in the current by-laws will be added to the duties of the Vice-President.
- 4. Revise Article IV, Section 1 to delete Vice-President of Concours and add Vice-President for Membership, Vice-President for Activities and Newsletter Editor. (Note: currently the V-P Membership and the Newsletter Editor position are held by the same person but in the event these positions are held by different people, both positions will be on the Board). Also, add to this section as a member of the board the new position of Member-At-Large. This will be a position which is not an officer position since it carries no specific duties but will be a voting member of the Board of Directors.
- 5. Revise Article IV, Section 2 to add language to make clear that if a person holds two officer positions, he or she will have only one vote on the Board of Directors.
