Georgia Aquarium Hosts Car Show

The Georgia Aquarium and Atlanta Classic Car Show invite you to take your imagination for a spin around the Largest Aquarium in the World. On October 22nd & 23rd, they'll open the "hood" on the Aquarium and feature some of the most exceptionally rare, museum-quality examples of the finest American and European cars from the 1930s through the present day.

This year's collection includes one of the rarest and most extraordinary examples of American automobile design, the 1961 Mako Shark concept vehicle - the inspiration for the 1963-1967 Chevrolet Corvette Stingray. The Mako Shark is considered one of the most

influential concept vehicles in history. It was designed to resemble a real shark, with a streamlined body, mouth, gills and a paint scheme that graduated from blue/gray on the top to silver/white on the bottom, mimicking the coloration of the shark that inspired it. Memorable features include a sharp, menacing "nose" and four-into-two side pipes. The Mako Shark heavily influenced the body design of Corvettes for decades. The vehicle is generously loaned for display at this show by the General Motors Heritage Museum of Sterling Heights, Michigan. Rarely on exhibit anywhere outside of the Heritage Museum.



Any Possibility Jaguar's C-X16 Concept Could Be Produced?

The two-seater concept was introduced at the Frankfurt Auto Show September 13th . Billed as

"one of the greenest sports cars, as well as one of the fastest," by Jaguar's brand director Adrian Hallmark, it is being promoted as a hybrid gasoline-electric vehicle.

There's no lack of excitement in the "production concept" specs. A supercharged, 3.0-liter V-6 breathes out 375 horsepower and 332 pound-feet of torque, which could push this sports car to 0-60 times in the 4.4-second range, and up to a top speed of 186 mph. A "push to pass" button controls something dubbed a "hybrid boost function," which can send more power to the rear wheels when it's wanted or needed--using its 70 kW electric motor and auxiliary battery pack. It also offers engine shut-off at idle and emits lowered levels of CO2 (165g/km).


Ian Callum, the lead designer at Jaguar, said that the family resemblance to the E-Type is more in the mind than the eye. "We all loved the E-Type Jaguars, but with

today's safety regulations you can't build something that looks like an E-Type anymore," he said. "You couldn't get the extremity of form that that car actually had."

Could a production version debut before the end of

next year? If so, should it wear an XE badge--since, as Jaguar promises, it should be the real successor to the E-Type celebrating its 50th anniversary this year?


