



Time is running short for registering your car in our 10th annual Concours d'Elegance on October 7th. Registrations forms can be found both at the end of this newsletter or at the North Georgia Jaguar Club website. The deadline for registration is September 17th, two weeks before the show. Don't forget that the brunch is free for two people per car, and \$26 per guest. Also, there will be a Dutch treat dinner the evening before the show, and members are encouraged to attend. Contact Roy Cleveland or Pat Harmon if you would like to go. Their numbers are listed below. Directions to the Country Club are also at the end of this article.

LOCATION AND SCHEDULE: The NGJC's 2012 Concours d'Elegance will be held Sunday, October 7th at the Chattahoochee Country Club in Gainesville, Georgia. The Chattahoochee Country Club is located on Lake Lanier just off Highway 60 which connects Gainesville and Dahlonega (www. chattahoocheecountryclub.com). The club's address is 3000 Club Drive NW, Gainesville, GA 30506. Their phone number is 770-536-4461. The schedule for the day is as follows:

9:00 am - 11:00 am -- Arrival of cars. Please visit the registration desk and you will be given an information packet.

11:30 pm - 1:00 pm - Brunch.

1:00 pm - Rags down.

1:00 pm – 2:30 pm -- Judging of cars. Download the

rule books and judging guides at www.jcna.com 3:30 pm – 4:30 pm -- Presentation of awards at the pool pavilion.

BRUNCH:

The brunch, sponsored by Hennessy Jaguar, will be available in the clubhouse for our members and Concours entrants in a private dining room facing the lake. The Club dress code requires "Club Casual" which is essentially a collared shirt for men and equivalent for ladies. For JCNA members who enter a car in the Concours there will be no charge for brunch for you and one guest. Additional guests may have brunch by paying the club's brunch charge of \$26.00. All service charges and taxes are included in the brunch fee.

THE SHOW:

The Concours will be held in a reserved lot next to the clubhouse. This will be an officially sanctioned JCNA event and scores will count toward national standings. Vehicles entered in Champion, Driven, or Special classes will be judged. Cars may also be entered as Display Only. During judging, all cars are to be initially presented in "closed fashion," with factory-delivered accessories (e.g. license plate holders, tool kits, overmat etc.) displayed outside the car.

HOTEL:

For all of our registrants who will be staying overnight, we have arranged a special rate of \$94 per night at the Hilton Garden Inn downtown Gainesville, Georgia (www. hiltongardeninn.com). Please make reservations by calling the hotel at 770-532-3396. Be sure to ask for the North Georgia Jaguar Club rate. Your contact person is Maryanne Hendricks. The hotel address is 1735 Browns Bridge Rd, Gainesville, GA 30501, behind the Longhorn Steak House. Note: The hotel will provide water and a hose for those who wish to wash their car.

To reach the country club from this point: Right turn onto Browns Bridge Rd, turn left onto E.E.Butler Parkway and drive 4.1 miles. Note: the street changes names from E.E. Butler to Green St and then to GA 60/Thompson Bridge. Look for the sign for the Chattahoochee Country Club on the left and turn left onto Club Drive. Stay on Club Drive for a couple of miles to the end of the road to the Clubhouse. The parking for the Concours is on the right side after you enter the Club grounds.

Plan Now for October 7th Concourse in Gainesville

DIRECTIONS:

VIA I-85 South to Gainesville Georgia

- 1. I-85 south to exit 137 Jefferson/Gainesville head north to Gainesville on Highway 129. Highway 129 merges with Hwy. 60 (Brenau Univ. & P.O. on right)
- 2. Continue following the signs for Hwy. 60 North toward Dahlonega (Hwy. 129 & 60 diverge in front of the First Baptist Church) until you reach Thompson Bridge (about 3 miles from downtown)
- 3. After crossing Thompson Bridge, continue through the first red light and look for the first left turn (one-quarter mile) which is Club Drive (there is a country club sign at this turn)
- 4. Turn left onto Club Drive and continue for a couple of miles to the end of the road to the Clubhouse - our parking is on the right side after you enter the Club grounds
 - VIA I-85 TRAVELING North on I-85 toward Gainesville
- 1. Bear left onto I-985
- 2. Continue north on I-985 to Exit No. 22 (approx. 22 miles)
- 3. Take Exit No. 22 and turn left at the end of the exit ramp
- onto Hwy. 129 4. Continue 1.8 miles into Gainesville where Hwy. 129 merges with Hwy. 60 (Brenau Univ. & P.O. on right)
- 5. Continue following the signs for Hwy. 60 North toward Dahlonega (Hwy. 129 & 60 diverge in front of the First Baptist Church) until you reach Thompson Bridge (about 3 miles from downtown)
- 6. After crossing Thompson Bridge, continue through the

first red light and look for the first left turn (one-quarter mile) which is Club Drive (there is a country club sign at this turn)

- 7. Turn left onto Club Drive and continue for a couple of miles to the end of the road to the Clubhouse - our parking is on the right side after you enter the Club grounds
 - VIA GA 400 going through Gainesville
- 1. Proceed north on GA 400 to Exit No. 17 (26 miles from Perimeter Mall Exit)
- 2. Take Exit 17 & turn right at the end of the exit ramp onto Hwy. 306 East
- 3. Follow Hwy. 306 for 1 mile to an intersection with Hwy. 369 and continue through the intersection for 7 miles to the intersection with Hwy. 53
- 4. Turn right onto Hwy. 53 and continue into Gainesville (about 10 miles). Before the next turn you will pass a Chili's (on right). After passing Chili's, continue for about one-half mile to an intersection with Pearl Nix Pkwy and continue through Pearl Nix to the 2nd red light which is Washington St
- 5. Turn left onto Washington St. and continue for about one-half mile to an intersection with St. Paul's Methodist Church on the left
- 6. Turn left at the church onto Hwy. 60 and continue through Gainesville to Thompson Bridge which is about 3 miles (landmarks you will pass in order: Post Office, First Baptist Church, Publix)
- 7. Cross Thompson Bridge and continue through the first red 9. Turn right on Club Drive and continue for 0.5 mile to the light and look for the first left turn (one-quarter mile) which is Club Drive (there is a country club sign at this

turn)

- 8. Turn left onto Club Drive and continue for a couple of miles to the end of the road to the Clubhouse - our parking is on the right side after you enter the Club grounds
 - VIA GA 400 avoiding Gainesville (i.e., back roads)
- 1. Proceed north on GA 400 to Exit No. 17 (26 miles from Perimeter Mall Exit)
- 2. Take Exit 17 & turn right at the end of the exit ramp onto Hwy. 306 East
- 3. Follow Hwy. 306 for 1 mile to an intersection with Hwy. 369 and continue through the intersection for 7 miles to the intersection with Hwy. 53
- 4. Take a slight right onto Hwy 53 (Dawsonville Hwy) and continue for 4.9 miles to an intersection with Sardis Rd (There is a traffic light at the intersection and a gasoline station)
- 5. Turn left on Sardis Rd. and continue for 1.4 miles to a stop sign at an intersection with Allison Rd. (Note Sardis bears right at approx. 0.4 miles)
- 6. Turn left on Sardis Rd. and continue for 0.5 mile past Chestatee High School on the left to Antioch Campground Rd
- 7. Turn right onto Antioch Campground and continue for 1.1 mile to the stop sign at the intersection with East Lake Drive
- 8. Turn left on East Lake Dr. and continue for 1.5 miles to the stop sign intersection with Club Drive
- Chattahoochee Country Club.

More recently, the system has become popular outside the industry due to its fast readability and large storage capacity compared to standard UPC barcodes. The code consists of black modules (square dots) arranged in a square pattern on a white background. With a smart phone app. you can scan and link directly to our NGJC website.
